Schools of Architecture Competition Charrette

Two Day Competition - \$5,500 in Prizes

Saturday Feb. 23- Sunday Feb. 24, 2013

INTRODUCTION

AIA Ohio is sponsoring the first AIA Ohio Schools of Architecture Competition Charrette. The goals of the competition include:

- Increasing interaction between the schools of architecture and the profession by engaging students, professors and professionals during the charrette, the School Jury and the State Jury.
- Increasing interaction between the students of local school programs (architecture, landscape architecture, interiors and planning) by promoting team submissions that foster collaboration.
- Promoting a local design challenge by encouraging the AIA Chapters to publish the winners through advocacy efforts.

DESIGN BRIEF

The competition will be for a "Camp David" retreat center. The mission of the facility will be to provide a retreat center on the edge of the University of Cincinnati campus to promote engagement, interaction, and collaboration between the school of architecture and the local community. The facility will include exhibit / gallery spaces, meeting / seminar rooms, offices, and multiuse areas to promote educational outreach and advocacy for quality design of the built environment.

STUDENT ELIGIBILITY

Submissions will be accepted from individuals or teams (with a maximum of 4 team members). Students are encouraged to collaborate vertically within their programs and eligible schools. Each submission shall have a minimum of one student from the undergraduate or graduate architecture program. Submissions will be accepted from undergraduates and graduates in the following schools:

- **Kent State University**, College of Architecture & Environmental Design: Architecture Program; Interior Design Program; and Urban Design program.
- **Miami University**, Department of Architecture + Interior Design: Architecture Program; and Interior Design Program.
- **Ohio State University**, Knowlton School of Architecture: Architecture Program; Landscape Architecture Program; and City and Regional Planning Program.
- **University of Cincinnati**, College of Design, Architecture, Art, and Planning: Architecture Program; Interior Design Program; and School of Planning.

AWARDS / PRIZES

School Jury

- First Place: \$500 (1 per each School of Architecture)
- Select 5 finalists (including the First Place Winner) to submit to the State Jury

State Jury

- First Place: \$2,000
- Second Place: \$1000
- Third Place \$500
- Honorable Mentions as determined by Jury
- Winners and honorable mentions will be on display at the Ohio Valley Regional Convention in 2013.
- AIA Ohio will publish the winners on the AIA Ohio website and in the summer newsletter.
- Local AIA Chapters will publish the winners.

SUBMISSION DETAILS

Submission Requirements for School Jury

- Each design submission shall be one 30"x40" sheet. Suggested information on the presentation sheet can include, (but is not required) a description of the design solution, plans, sections, elevations, perspectives, renderings, diagrams etc.
- The submission shall also include a copy of the Concealed Project Credit & Information Form.

Submission Requirements for State Jury Finalists

- Each of the four School Juries will select finalists to be submitted to the State Jury. Each finalist shall be printed on a 30"x40" sheet and submitted to AIA Ohio.

TIMELINE

- The Competition Brief will be submitted to participating students, faculty and professionals: Monday, February 18, 2013.
- The Competition Charrette will occur on the weekend: Saturday Feb. 23-Sunday Feb. 24, 2013.
- Each School Jury will evaluate the submissions and select finalists: Week of February 25, 2013.
- State Jury for Winners: March 15, 2013 during the AIA Ohio board meeting at the University of Cincinnati.

CHAMPIONS

- School Champions (Professors) from each school will be identified in advance and encouraged to provide critiques for the students during the weekend charrette.
- Chapter Champions (Professionals) from each local AIA Chapter will be identified in advance and encouraged to provide critiques for the students during the weekend charrette.

JURY

School Jury

- The School Jury will be composed of three school professors and three AIA professionals selected by the local AIA Chapter. The jury shall be by individuals who did not participate in the charrette. Submissions shall be anonymous and the jury shall evaluate the submissions in an open format where students can be present to listen to the deliberations. The jury shall select the top five submissions to be sent to the State Jury and select one winner to receive the School Jury Award.

State Jury

- The State Jury will be composed of four school professors and four AIA professionals selected by AIA Ohio. Submissions shall be anonymous and the jury shall select the First, Second and Third Place winners. Honorable Mentions can be selected at the discretion of the jury.
